MHCD QUICK FACTS

In 1991, healthcare workers at the Mental Health Center of Denver built power by forming their union. The fact is without a union you don't have a voice in the work place. Without a voice, management can change working conditions however and whenever they want. Let's learn from the past!

The Union Difference

- * Almost all union workers (89%) have access to employer provided health insurance, compared with 67% for non-union workers.
- * Union workers pay less for health benefits than other mental health workers in the Denver Metro area.
- * Union workers are likely to receive paid time off benefits with greater amounts of paid time off.
- * People of color and women earn more as union members. Women earn 34% more, Black workers earn 29% more, Latino workers earn 59% more, and Asian workers make 11% more than non-union workers.
